

First Day Check List:

<p>Prior to first day:</p>	<p>All completed forms and paperwork</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Registration form • Parent Handbook • Immunization form • Emergency Consent form • Neighborhood walk permission form • If needed: medication authorization form • If needed: individual medical care plan
<p>Daily supplies:</p>	<p>Backpack</p>	<p>Big enough to hold 9x12 paper and spare clothes/supplies/laundry.</p>
	<p>Lunch: Packed in insulated box or bag with ice packs</p>	
	<p>Water bottle</p>	
	<p>Small laundry bag (not mesh) or gallon size zip lock bags</p>	<p>To keep in backpack or cubby, for sending home soiled clothes.</p>
	<p>Weather appropriate outerwear</p>	<p>Rain suit or rain pants and rain boots in rainy season. Boots can live at school.</p>
	<p>Outside shoes: please no laces (unless you child can tie them independently) or flip flops!</p>	<p>Optional: you may leave a pair of rain boots or crocs at school depending on the season</p>
<p>Weekly supplies:</p>	<p>Masks: we strongly recommend kid sized kn-95s or reusable multilayer masks that offer similar filtration.</p>	<p>Children should have at least two spare masks at all times. Worn washable masks will be sent home daily for washing</p>
	<p>Diapers/pull ups</p>	<p>As needed.</p>
	<p>Nap blanket</p>	<p>Optional: Stuffed animal, pillow for napping or picture books/quiet activities for resting</p>
	<p>Two full changes of clothing</p>	<p>For children who are learning to use the toilet, please supply additional pants and undies.</p>
<p>To keep at school:</p>	<p>Emergency kit (These items will be packed away and your child will not have access, so do not pack favorites!)</p>	<p>Pajamas, three days/nights supply of socks, diapers and/or underwear, family pictures, and emergency medications in large zip lock bag labeled with your child's name and phone number.</p>

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	Emergency, as-needed, daily medications: (i.e., epi-pens, inhalers, etc.)	All medications must be provided in original containers with a copy of the prescription that shows dosing instructions and prescribing physician and a note signed and dated by parents with instructions for administration.
	OTC medications or treatments: (i.e., diaper ointment, anti-itch cream, etc.)	All non-prescription items must come in original packaging with ingredients and administration instructions, labeled with the child's full name and a parent note signed and dated with administration instructions.
	Optional: sunscreen	we will have sunscreen at school, but if you prefer a particular brand or type, you may send a bottle to keep at school labeled with your child's name.

-Please label EVERYTHING with your child's first name and last initial! This includes all clothing items, shoes, coats, lunch boxes or bags, water bottles, etc...

-Parents are welcome to bring a pair of croc-like shoes or rain boots (depending on the season) to keep at school for outdoor play.

-We get messy at school, inside and outside! Please send your child in play clothes that you don't mind getting dirty or stained.

-Sunscreen should be applied prior to drop off. We will reapply as needed throughout the day.

-We encourage families to pack lunches in resealable containers to minimize waste.

-Due to Covid, we ask that families pack everything their child will need to eat their lunch, including utensils and a cloth or paper napkin.
